

## **The impact of this funding last year (2016/2017)Whitfield Valley**

### **Key Stage 2 Attainment**

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 80% which was 15% above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 79% which was 3% above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in GPS was 79% which was 5% above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in maths was 82% which was 8% above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above combined was 66% which was 16% above the national average

### **Key Stage 1 Attainment**

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 84% which was above the national average for this group.
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 78% which was above the national average for this group.
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in maths was 82% which was above the national average for this group.
- In all areas there were no significant differences in outcomes between disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged pupils.

### **Year 1 Phonics attainment**

- disadvantaged pupils achieved 86% which was 20% above the national average for this group. There was no difference between disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged pupils in this outcome.

### **EYFS**

- The percentage of pupils with entitlement to FSM achieving a good level of development was above the national average at 82% compared with 52% nationally. There was no significant difference in the outcome of non-disadvantaged pupils and disadvantaged.
