The impact of this funding last year (2017/2018) Whitfield Valley



Key Stage 2 Attainment

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 96% which was 31% above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 82% which was 6% above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in GPS was 96% which was 22% above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in maths was 96% which was 22% above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above combined was 82% which was 32% above the national average

Key Stage 1 Attainment

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 91% which was above the national average for this group.
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 91% which was above the national average for this group.
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in maths was 91% which was above the national average for this group.

Year 1 Phonics Attainment

- disadvantaged pupils achieved 88% which was 22% above the national average for this group. There was no difference between disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged pupils in this outcome.

EYFS Attainment

The percentage of pupils with entitlement to FSM achieving a good level of development was above the national average at 74% compared with 52% nationally. There was no significant difference in the outcome of non-disadvantaged pupils and disadvantaged
